

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (120 hours)

This is a recommended course sequence based on the UHD 2023-24 Undergraduate Catalog for a degree in Baccalaureate Degree in the Science of Nursing which equips students to progress in their professional nursing career. Courses with asterisks (*) indicate Common Core courses.

The BSN degree is a completion degree which requires students who enter the program to have an associate’s degree in nursing and an RN licensure prior. The courses below are the specific courses UHD that eligible students must take to complete the BSN. In addition, if students who join the program have not completed their common core requirements, they will need to complete those courses as part of the BSN degree.
