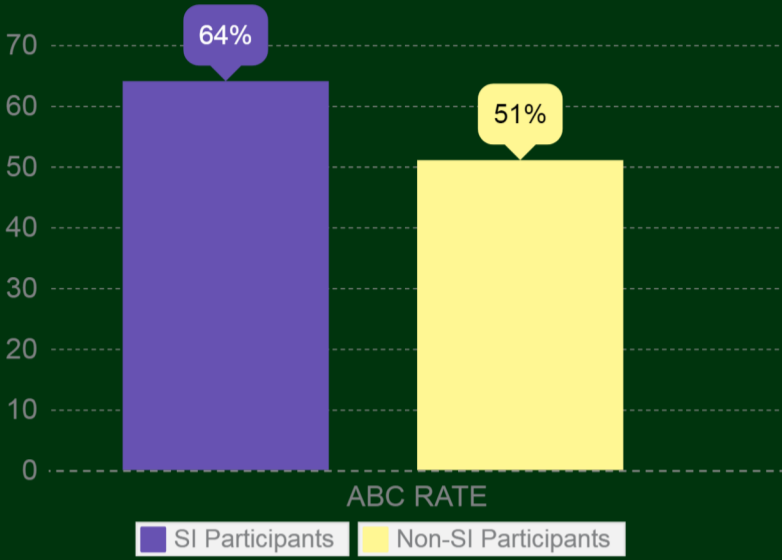


IMPACT OF SI ON GRADES SPRING 2015

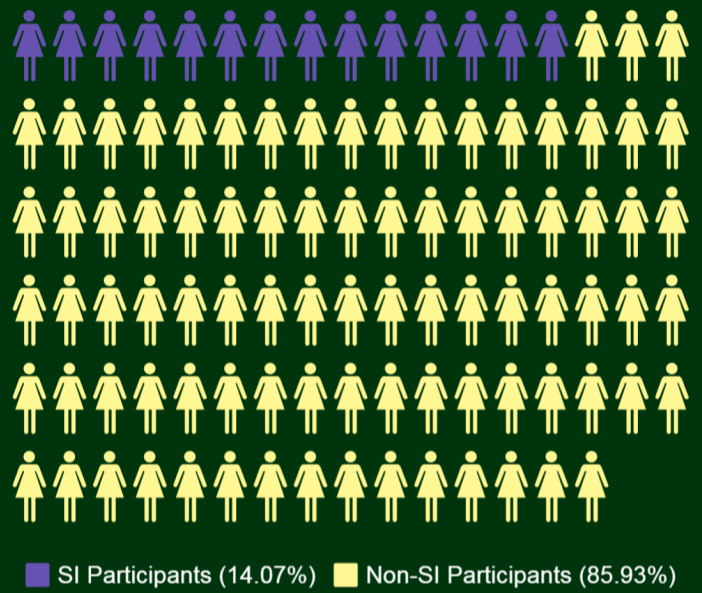
OVERVIEW



In Spring 2015, the University of Houston-Downtown SI Program offered over 1,600 sessions with an average of 2 student attending per session.

Across all sections, 62% of students who attended SI came to sessions more than once.

Withdrawals ▼



The data above represents the percentage of withdrawals per group divided by the total number of students in SI sections who withdrew.

- **39%** Overall attendance to SI sessions
- **2515** Number of contact hours
- **0.5** GPA difference between SI participants and non-participants

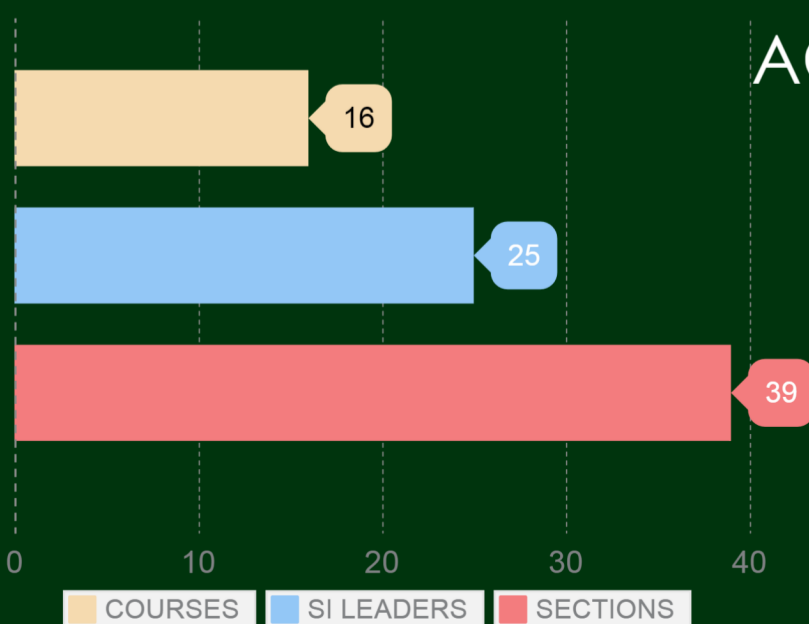
